Just in time for fall hunt tests, the handler's seminar will be held on the same grounds as our upcoming October 14-16 test, which offers a double/double in all stakes!

Our purpose is not to train you or your dog, but to teach you the ins and outs of handling your dog in a senior or master level stake. Although this is a seminar for handlers, the best way to learn is to get behind the steering wheel. Dog/handler teams will participate in a number of possible scenarios to help them prepare for the unexpected. We will use both pigeons and quail to work with green broke dogs, as well as, those ready for the master level. Blank and live gunfire will be used.

Of course, it can't all be done in a weekend but we hope you will be inspired and continue to train with a plan to achieve these upper level titles with style.

DIRECTIONS: I-20 to Wills Point. Take Exit Number 519, the Turner – Hayden Exit. Go approximately 2 miles North on 3412 to the intersection of 3406/3412. Continue an additional quarter mile. Entrance to the ranch is on the right-hand side. Use the 2nd entrance closest to the white barn.

From Southeast: Take 64 in Canton. Cross over I-20. Turn left on VZCR 3406. (If you get to HWY 80 you've gone too far.) Turn right at the 1st intersection on to VZCR 3412. Ranch is the second drive on the right.

From HWY 80 in Wills Point: Go through Wills Point heading east. Veer right at the split on to HWY 64. Turn right on VZCR 3406. Turn right at the intersection on to VZCR 3412. Ranch is the second drive on the right.

Coordinates are N32.65078° W095.98235°

Camping is not available.

Saturday:

- Open with discussion
 - Explanations about each stake
 - AKC rules
 - Running a stake from the judge's viewpoint
- Teams work in the field
- Proof steady to wing and shot
- Honoring a bracemate
- Use of blank or live gunfire
- Handler carries both for Master level
 - (bring yours if available)
- Experience running with a bracemate

Both Mr. Henderson and experienced club members will be available to answer questions about the AKC events and work with teams.

Sunday:

- Hunt Test simulation with running order
 - Each dog will run with a bracemate
 - Blank guns or gunners with live fire will be used
 - Each handler will be coached during brace
 - Quail to be used with regard to cover
- Cost covers workshop and birds appropriate for each session per dog per day

Things you will need:

- A good recall/control
- Sturdy collar and leash
 - (e-collar for training purposes-not mandatory)
- Blank gun and/or shotgun (fake or actual)
- Water for dogs, chair for yourself
- Easy-up or some shelter from sun if available
- BYO lunch and soft drinks. Water provided
